





ASSORTED TRIVIA THAT SCOOT DEEMED IMPORTANT TO RELAY


- We rolled a combined 206 games with a score of 200 or higher, the 5th most of any season in league history.
- In terms of overall league average, this was our 4th highest season with 160.9295.
- Monica Hufford made her debut as the 5th best female bowler in league history.
- Aaron Barber moved up to the #10 spot for best bowlers of all time. Only 4 of those ranked above him have bowled in recent seasons.
- In game 1 of week 14, Bob Brunker's 204 was his 100th 200+ game.
- Game 1 of week 7 was Dennis Laube's 1,500th recorded game of bowling in our league, the first to reach this milestone.
- In week 11, Aubrey Moren's 672 series was his 50th career 600+ series.
 He is the 5th bowler to reach this milestone.
- Always having to one-up Aubrey, in week 13 the 699 series rolled by Kody Karnes was his 100th career 600+ series. He is the 3rd person to reach this number.
- The mutual 725s rolled by Splitbowl Countries and HoF Sandwich in Week 14, game 1 is the highest scoring game ever among teams of four that resulted in a tie.
- Everybody liked to complain about mechanical problems with lanes 7&8, but overall bowlers performed better on those lanes than any other pair we rolled on this season (including the week they shifted us down) other than lanes 3&4. Not surprisingly, our worst pair of lanes was the set abutting the other league.

- In all 37 seasons now in the record books, there have been only 10 instances of a bowler rolling a single game whose score ended up being at least half of their series total. Oddly, two of those instances happened this season:
 - In week 9, Brian Byfield (avg 136 that week) rolled a 226 in his first game that went on to become 50.67% of his 446 series.
 - Two weeks later, Pat Hamell (avg 122 that week) topped that by rolling a 202 in game 3 that accounted for 52.88% of his 382 series.
 - Of course the overall record holder for this will likely never be topped. It was in week 2 of Fall 2005, when Lauren Schuster (avg 106) followed up a 73 and a 65 with a 214, which accounted for 60.8% of her 352 series.
- > WITNESS!!!'s 25-7 first-half win record is tied for 5th highest ever.
- Matthew Taylor is the 3rd best bowler in league history without a championship, followed by Dennis Walling in 4th and Russell Bingham in 6th. Those three are the only recently-active bowlers with averages above 180 who haven't won a title yet.
- Nick Kinney's week 3 was the 9th highest power ranked performance in league history. He is also the 4th biggest sandbagger in league history, "miraculously improving" his average by 31 pins.
- In game 3 on week 7, JoAnne Gordon (avg 115 at the time) rolled a 191. Aaron Barber (avg 204 at the time) rolled a 178. This was the 8th biggest whooping of a top bowler by an underdog in league history.



P&P PILLAR AWARD

Demond Robinson









Even though he has not been seen in our league since the Fall 2005 session, Demond "Big D" Robinson dominated many of our Top 25 lists all the way up through 2014. While his legacy has begun fading in recent years, as of this writing he still holds onto 2nd place among best secondhalf win records, 8th place among bowlers to reach 100 wins in the fewest number of games, 14th among best bowlers by win percentage, and 21st for holding the weekly high game scratch.

As both a teammate and a competitor, Robinson was second to none when it came to encouraging those around him. His inviting personality in-between rolls was always a welcome distraction despite the intensity going on during close matchups. Focus, however, was the name of the game when it came time for him to step up on the lanes. In the Fall 2004 season, the league voted him as the Carl Goetz Defensive Bowler of the Season and and People's Choice for Most Valuable Bowler. They were right, as the math proved he was the Actual Most Valuable Bowler that same season.

Demond's dedication reached its peak on the final day of his career with our league: December 20, 2005. It was championship week, and while his team (Same Belt, New Notch) was in the lead, it did not have the trophy locked up. Despite recovering from surgery, Demond rolled a 206 in his final game in our league to help secure the title and make himself, Seth, and Scoot the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th bowlers to win three consecutive titles.
